

PROCEDURES/POLICIES and STATEMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY
2010-11 Lindbergh School District Bands (page 1 of 2)

The following rules are established as procedures for all trips by all Lindbergh School District Bands during the 2010-2011 school year:

READ ALL ITEMS CAREFULLY, SIGN AND RETURN TO BANDSTANDERS
BY APRIL 30, 2010.

1. All policies and regulations of Lindbergh School District are in effect during trips. **Violations of these policies will result in students being sent home at parent's expense and referred for additional action.**
2. **Absolutely no smoking or use of illegal and/or intoxicating substances will be permitted or tolerated. This will be STRICTLY ENFORCED per school district policies.**
3. Students will show proper respect and courtesy to all Lindbergh staff and parent chaperones. Abusive language **will not** be tolerated.
4. Band member rooms, luggage and personal equipment will be subject to search at anytime by school personnel.
5. Conduct on busses, airplanes, and in hotels and public places shall be orderly and reflect mature behavior.
6. Everyone is to adhere to the schedule and be prompt on all occasions. **DO NOT BE LATE.**
7. Every member of the band is responsible for his/her own uniform, instrument, and luggage. Band uniforms must be hung or laid neatly per instructions. Be sure to read the "**Statement of Responsibility**" on the reverse side.
8. **ALL** band members are to assist with loading and unloading the bus and equipment vehicles as instructed by staff or chaperones.
9. The use of electronic devices during rehearsals and performances is prohibited.
10. It is the band member's responsibility to observe all curfew and visitation rules and instructions.
11. Uniforms, both formal and informal are to be worn completely without jewelry and other distracting effects. Casual dress codes at other times during the trip will be enforced at the discretion of the band staff.

I understand the above procedures and realize my failure to comply with these rules will result in immediate receipt of detention and/or restrictive supervision assignments, and place me subject to discipline guidelines established by the school administration. I understand the above procedures are effective immediately and will govern all trips with all Lindbergh School District Bands.

Uniforms:

Are to be worn with appropriate color boxers, crew socks, band shoes (ordered through band), t-shirts, and no jewelry.

Gloves:

These will be distributed at the first performance to each student. The gloves are yours to keep for the marching season -- we will announce when they are to be returned at the end of the season. Students not returning gloves will be charged the above replacement cost. Anyone without gloves or with gloves that have not been laundered will be given another pair to wear, but they also will be charged for them. The charge will be reversed when one clean pair is returned.
