Dear Band Parents,

We are pleased to announce our next Tournament of Roses Parade fundraiser, a golf tournament, scheduled for Sunday, September 19, at Sunset Lakes Golf Course. We will be joined at dinner by special guest, Fox 2 News meteorologist, Glenn Zimmerman, who is a Lindbergh High School band alumnus. The tournament will be a great way to get some more money in your student's account and also raise funds to support scholarships to provide help to families that need assistance in order for their child to be able to participate in the Rose Parade.

The cost of participation in the tournament will be \$100 per golfer. This price includes 18 holes of golf, drinks and either, breakfast and lunch, or dinner, depending on whether the morning or afternoon flight is selected. The preferred golf flight will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis. There will also be a closest-to-the-pin, longest drive and hole-in-one contests.

By registering golfers for the tournament, your student's account will directly benefit by [\$45] for each golfer registered. Payment can be made by cash, check or credit card. Registration and payment can be dropped in the green box in the band room or mailed to the address on the brochure. We will also be reaching out to the community and businesses to support the band through purchasing one of three different sponsorship levels, registering to participate in the tournament and providing items for a raffle.
